Small Manuscript Collections describes many small collections of personal papers, business records, and documents, acquired by the San Francisco History Center by gift and purchase. The collection is unrestricted, except where noted. Requests for permission to reproduce or publish material from the collection should be discussed with the reference staff.

Processing was begun by Terry Horrigan in 1990 and continued by Marianne Carden and Thomas Carey in December 1995. As new material is being added continuously, this Guide is regularly updated.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Small Manuscript Collections reveal, to a large degree, various aspects of San Francisco's 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> century history and, to a lesser degree, the history of California and the West. The materials shed light on many elements of local and state history, including politics, social movements and cultural developments, and natural and man-made disasters.

The Collections are predominantly made up of correspondence, although records comprise a good portion. Correspondents and diarists include both historically significant individuals and the anonymous gold miner. Individuals' scrapbooks are found here, but the patron should also check the San Francisco History Center's separate Scrapbook Collection for this type of material. Included are some organizational records. Documents include abstracts of title, probates, licenses, deeds, leases, powers of attorney, bonds, bills of exchange, receipts, certificates, tax bills and naturalization papers. Papers and records occasionally are written in foreign languages, primarily Spanish, French, German and Dutch. Earliest materials in the collection include a letter from Thomas Larkin in Monterey to William Davis, 1846, with reference to the possibility of war with Mexico, and William Leidesdorff's account book for his trading schooner *Julia Ann*, dating from 1845.

A Subject Guide to the collections directs users from topics to creators (author or corporate entity.) This is followed by a box list. The user will note that for some correspondence and records, a typewritten transcript and/or photocopy is available. When requesting material, a patron should indicate the box and folder number. Example:
