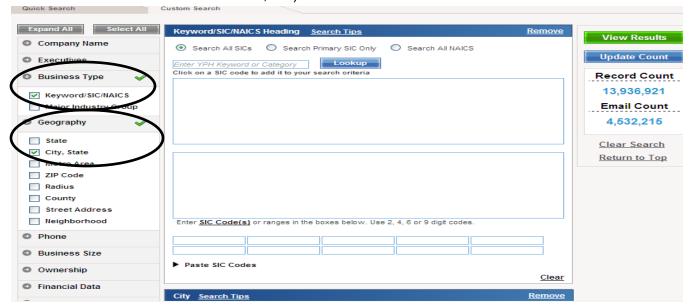
Using Reference USA in your Job Search

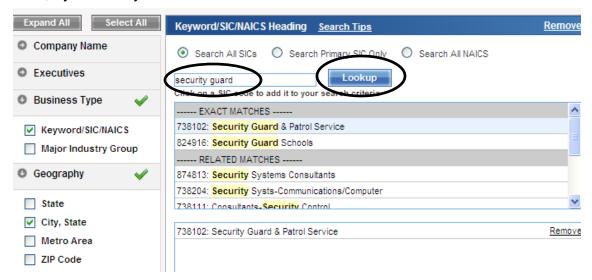
How to find all the companies in San Francisco in a selected field of business

On the SFPL Database list, click on **Reference USA**. When it starts up, click on **U.S. Businesses**, then click on the **Custom Search** tab.


On the list on the left side of the page, click to open options for **Business Type** (select **Keyword/SIC/NAICS)** and **Geography** (select **City, State** – or for a broader search, you could chose **Metro Area** or **State**, etc).



Enter a keyword for the kind of business you want to find in the box under the Keyword/SIC/NAICS Bar and click Lookup. Click on the best choices, which will move them to the big box. Look for all that seem related to your search. If there are no good choices, try other keywords.



Go down toward the bottom of the page under the **City** bar. In the **Select a State** box select California, then type all or part of the city name (San Francisco) in the box right under it and find it in the **Available** box. Click on the city name to move it to the **Selected box**. Click on **View Results** button



Here is a list of all the companies who are in the business of hiring security guards and providing them to clients. It includes addresses and phone numbers for the businesses. More information about each company is available by clicking on the name of the company (it will be blue). On the company page, click on **Expand All** under **Quicklinks** for more information. This technique will work for a variety of jobs where you want a list of potential employers.
